We look forward to helping them succeed in 2024 and beyond!



Highlights over the past year....

- * 52 people contacted PBL for literacy assistance
- * 20 students improved their English skills
- * 900+ hours of instructional time were provided
- * 11 volunteers aided 16 students in their learning goals
- * 11 students attended English language classes
- * 6 students participated in online learning
- * 2 students recently passed the HiSET
