Crystal joined our group HiSET class in early 2016. At that time, she and her young daughter were living in a shelter, struggling to make ends meet, while her two older children lived in Massachusetts. In May 2016, Crystal successfully completed the HiSET and received her high school diploma. Since then, Crystal has had steady employment, and has obtained housing of her own and a reliable car.

In 2019, her teenage son, Anthony, came to live with her so he could

complete high school here in New Hampshire. When COVID hit, Anthony found it difficult to engage with remote learning and the frequent switching between virtual and in-person learning. In early 2021, when he turned 18, Crystal and Anthony reached out to PBL for help. We provided him with study and academic skills support, and he thrived. In May 2021, Anthony successfully completed his HiSET, joining Crystal as the first parent/child team to complete HiSET through Pemi-Baker Literacy. Imagine Crystal's pride when she got the news. Anthony is currently working full time while deciding what his next steps will be. We are proud of them both and are grateful to have been part of their journey.
